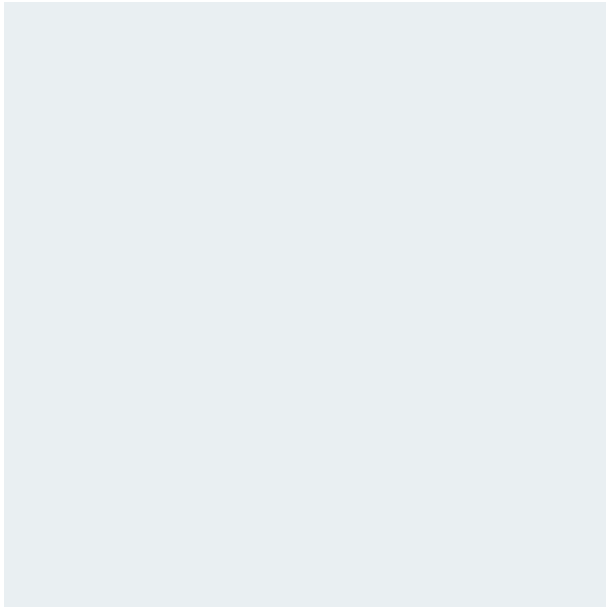

The warm white sands of the endless ocean beach inspired this elegant new coloured steel.

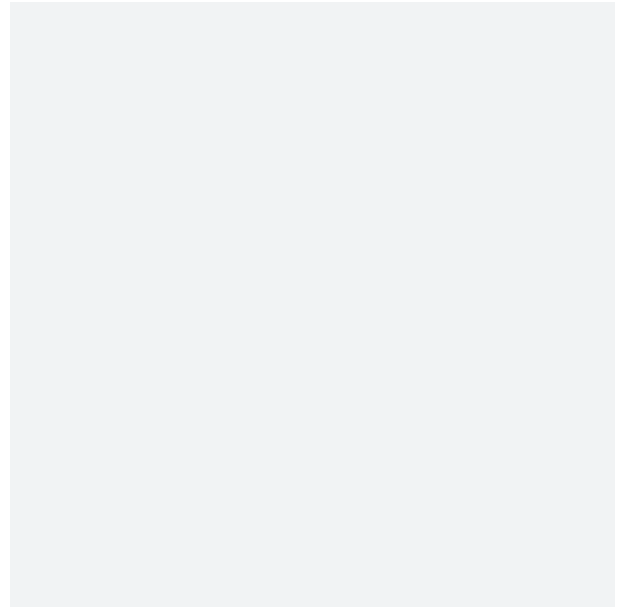

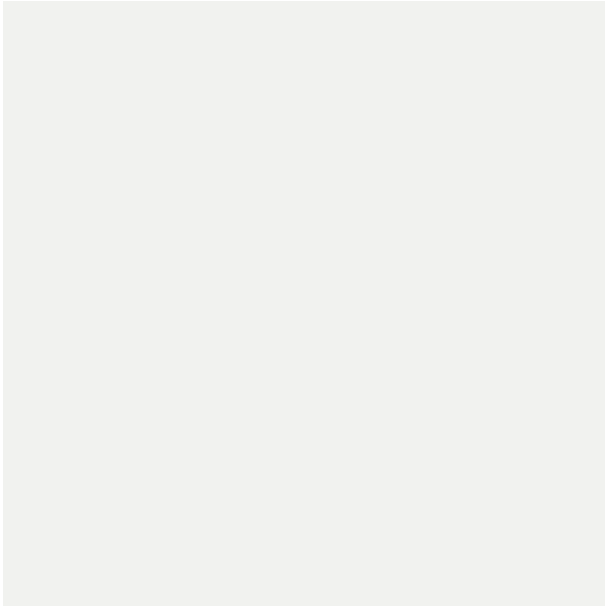

Dramatic pink granite peaks, secluded bays, white sandy beaches... this is Freycinet.

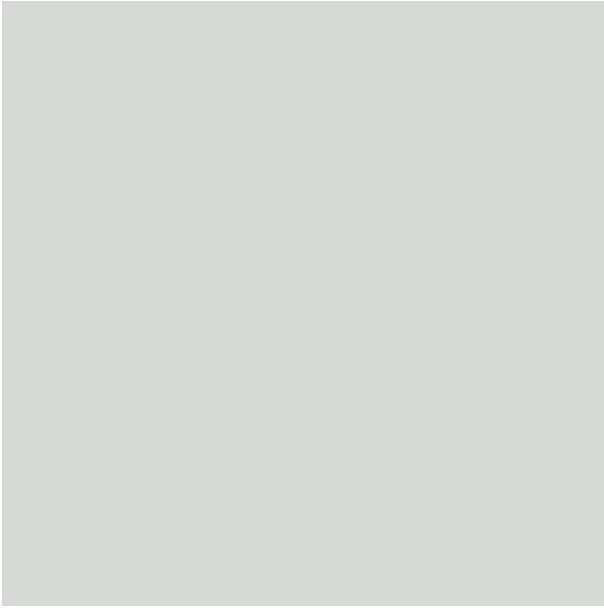

Of late it has become a wildlife sanctuary with a focus on the Yellow-Footed Rock-Wallaby.

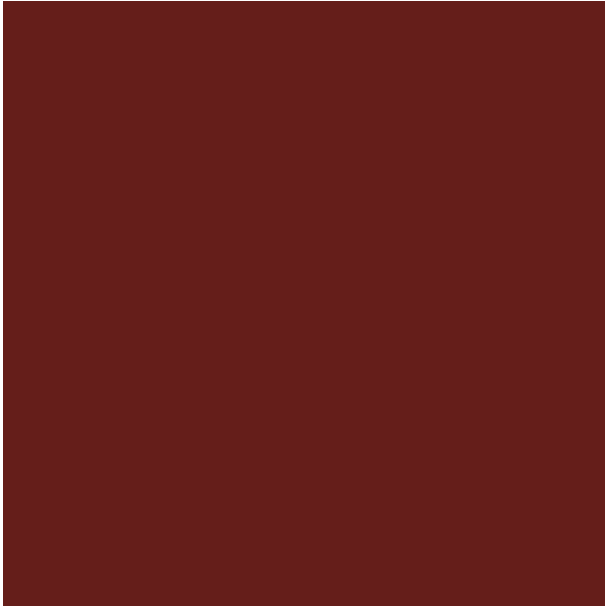

This is a true Australian colour; it is the colour of the heart of our country.

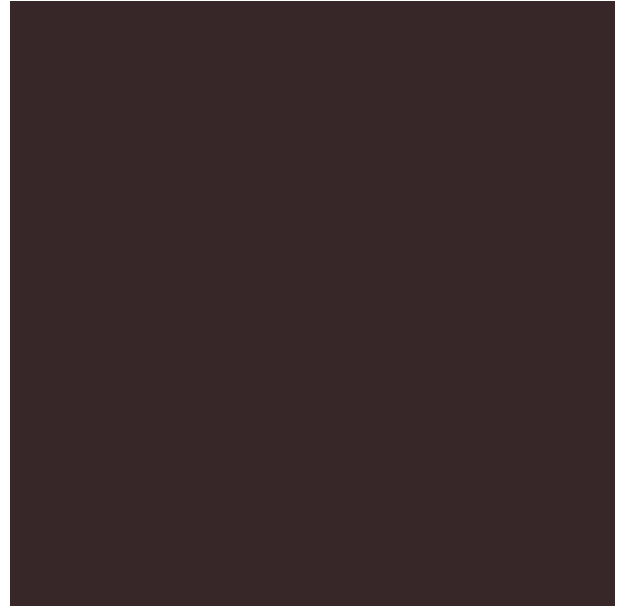

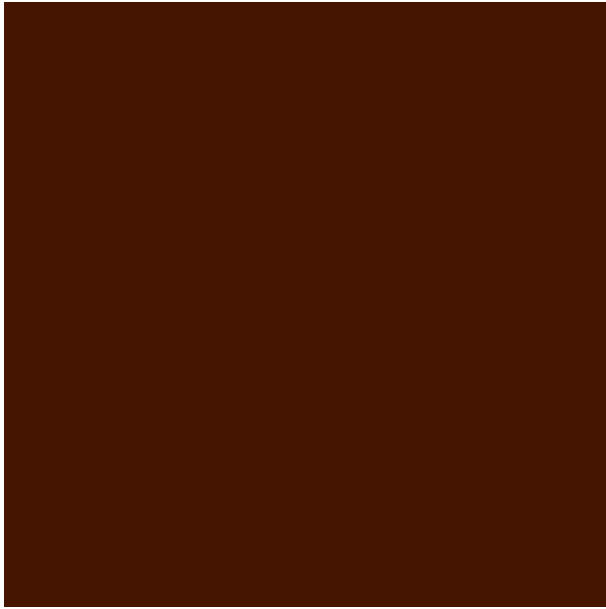

After endless kilometres of featureless desert, the usual question on the journey is 'where can I get a bloody beer' and the answer is of course, Inna-bloody-mincka.

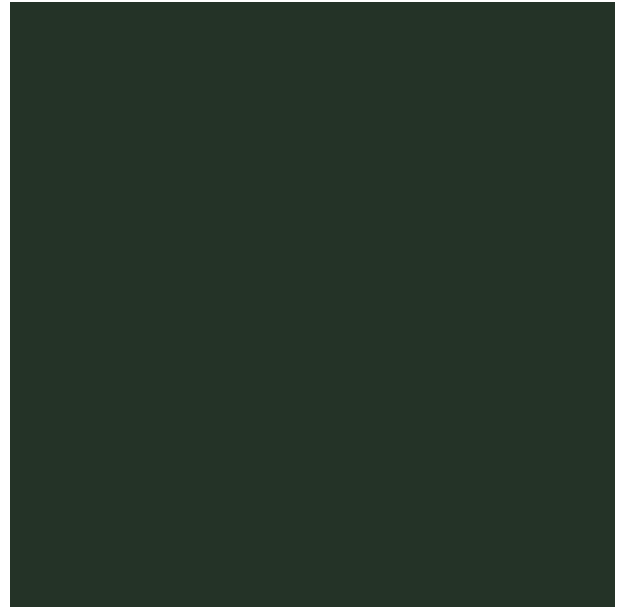

It still lives on as a luxury retreat and this elegant designer grey in our Australis palette.

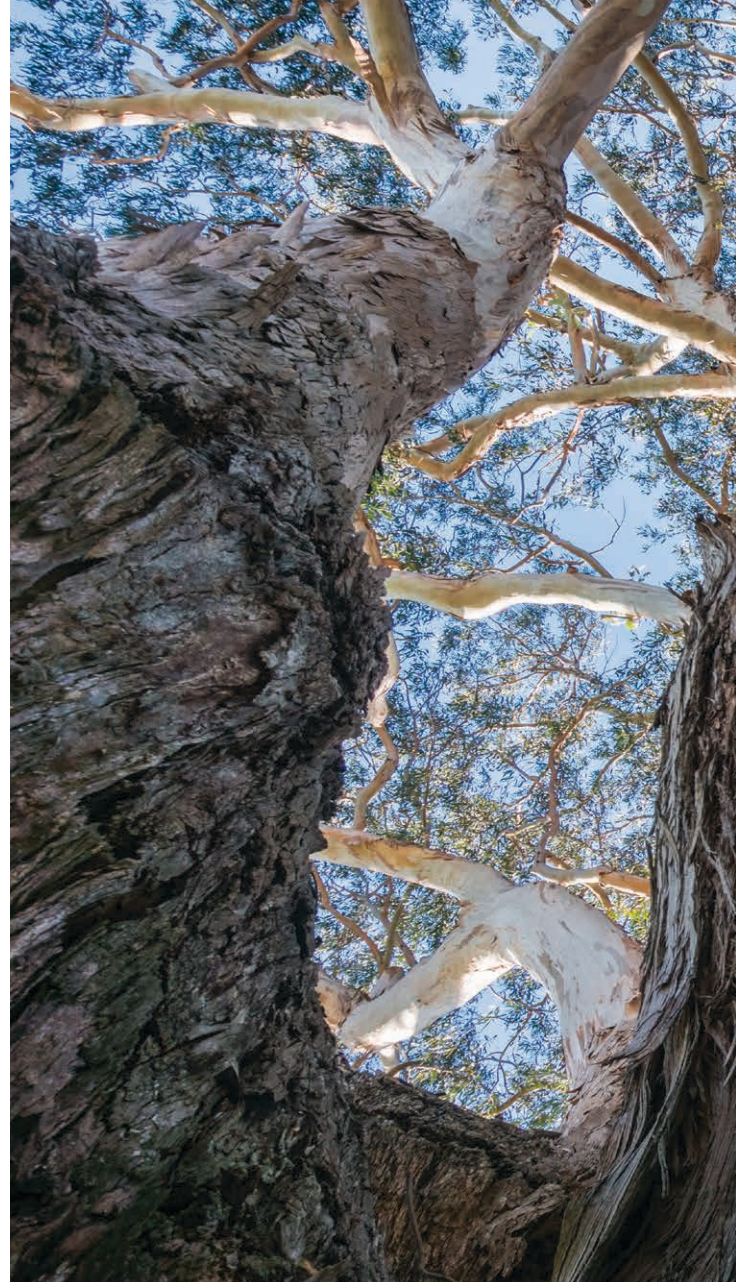

Seen from the air, it's an Australian painter's palette.

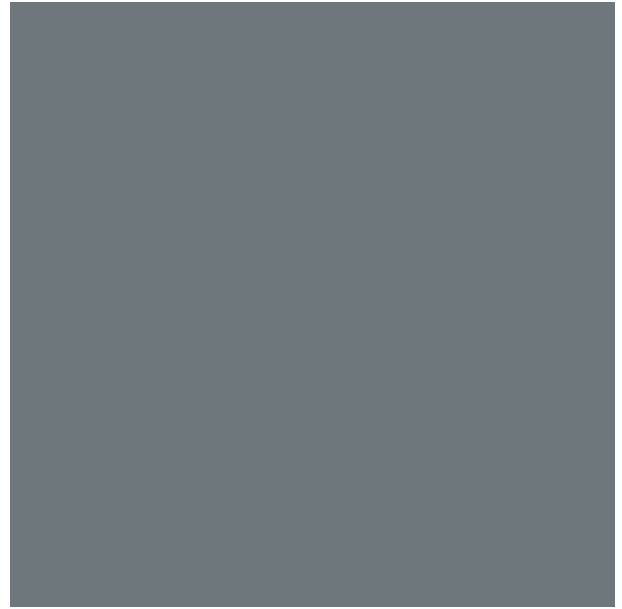

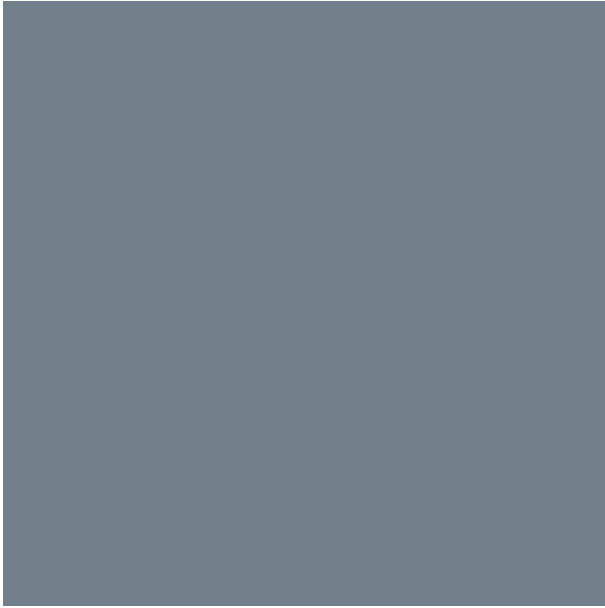

Ben Lomond is a “must-see” in summer and a “must-ski” in the cold Tasmanian winter.

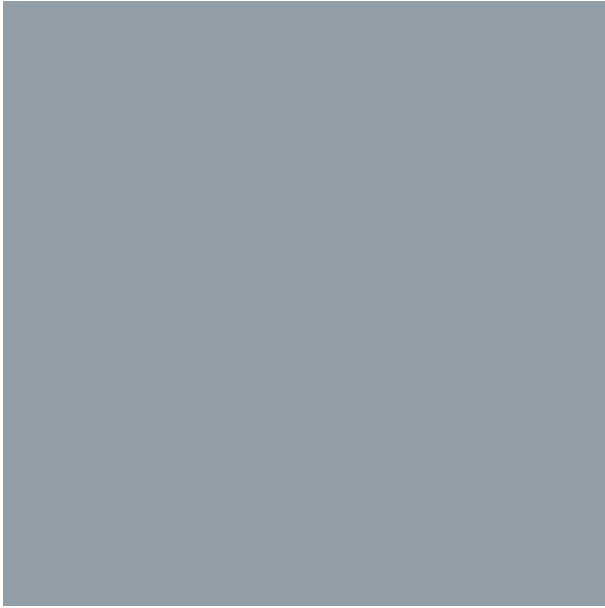

The national park was heritage-listed for its outstanding beauty and being one of the richest indigenous rock art sites in Australia.

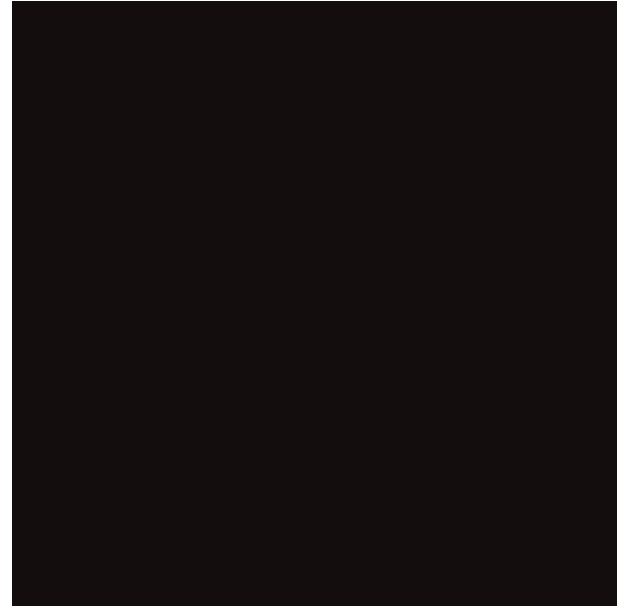

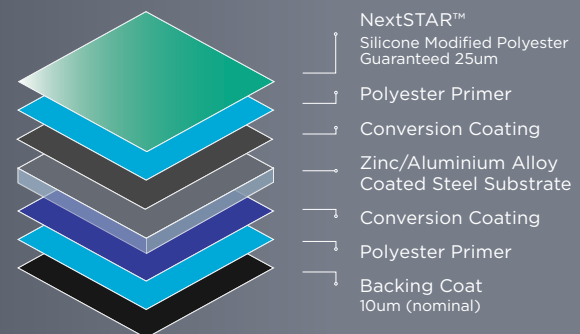
